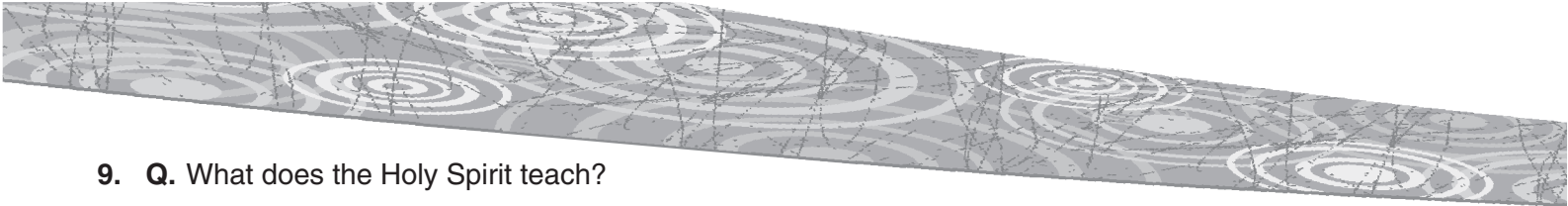

On the day of Pentecost the Holy Spirit endowed Peter with special wisdom. Peter declared the outpouring of the Spirit to be a fulfillment of Old Testament prophecy.

Moreover, he pointed out that the ministry of Christ with its wondrous miracles was approved of God. Furthermore, Peter related the Old Testament Scriptures to the recent events of the death and resurrection of Christ. The particular emphasis was on the truth that God the Father highly exalted Christ by giving Him the honourable position at His right hand.

The sermon reached its climax in the accusation of the audience. Peter's hearers were declared to be guilty of the most serious offence of crucifying the One who was highly favoured by the most high God.

The amazing effect of the Pentecost sermon likewise brought great glory to the Saviour. By the Spirit's grace, enemies were shown the greatness of their sin and guilt. They looked on Him whom they had pierced. They mourned for Him as one who mourns for his only son. Three thousand hearers were stricken with a godly sorrow.

Upon their inquiry, "What must we do to be saved?" They were pointed to the same Christ.

Seven weeks ago, in hatred, they had cried out, "Away with Him! Crucify Him!" Now, in their deep sorrow, they looked into the endless depth of Christ's forgiving heart and found in Christ a priceless healing balm.

How precious is the way in which the Holy Spirit glorifies the Saviour. He honours Christ by making room for Him. He brings the sinner low and humbles all his pride.

He leads the soul into such straits that none but Christ can save. He creates a thirst which Christ alone can quench. He wounds the heart and makes it plain that only Christ can heal. He reveals the unsearchable treasures of Christ's grace to needy sinners.

He glorifies the Saviour when the believer embraces Christ in His redeeming love. As a result, heaven is filled with gladness, and faith exclaims:

"He (Christ) is altogether lovely!"

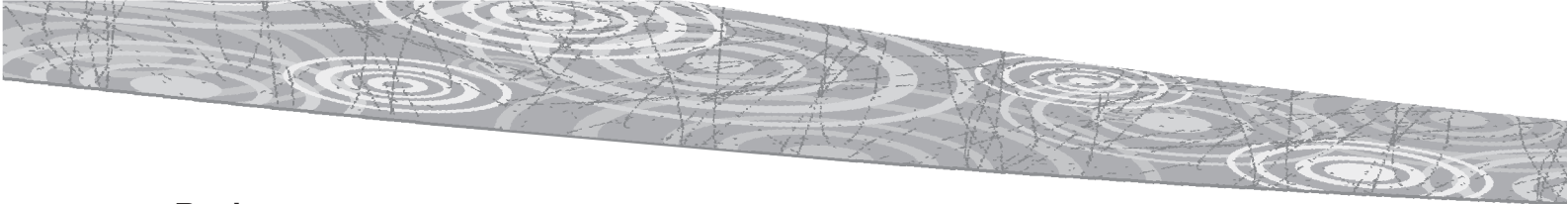
