## II Timothy

In the second letter to Timothy, Paul exhorts Timothy never to be ashamed of preaching the gospel, for at Christ's appearing, it will be proven to all that this gospel was the only hope for mankind. Timothy will be persecuted for it, but Paul admonishes him to be a good soldier of Jesus Christ. In chapter 3, Paul deals with the character of men in the last days. In the end of this chapter and in chapter 4, Paul gives his last charge to Timothy, knowing that the end of his ministry and death are very near.

### *Read II Timothy 1*

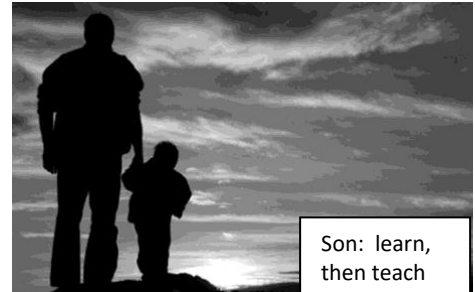
1. Paul prays for Timothy \_\_\_\_\_ greatly desiring to see him (Ch. 1: 3). Remember Paul is in prison in Rome. While in bonds there, he calls to remembrance Timothy's \_\_\_\_\_ that was first in his grandmother \_\_\_\_\_, and then in his mother \_\_\_\_\_.
2. Paul tells Timothy not to be ashamed of the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Lord nor of me his \_\_\_\_\_. (Ch. 1: 8) Timothy is to be a partaker of the \_\_\_\_\_ of the gospel according to the power of God, for Paul told Timothy a few verses later, "they that live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer \_\_\_\_\_. 3. What did Christ abolish for His Church? (Ch. 1: 10) \_\_\_\_\_ What did Christ bring for His Church? \_\_\_\_\_.
4. Paul tells Timothy to hold fast \_\_\_\_\_ words (Ch. 1: 13) which some turned from... namely \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_; but

\_\_\_\_\_ was not ashamed of Paul's chain. These are true friends. They didn't care about the stigma associated with visiting "bad" people in prison. They ministered to Paul's needs.

## *Read II Timothy 2*

In chapter 2, Paul gives a series of seven examples to demonstrate the duty and action of believers, actually, of everyone, but only that done out of true faith is honoring to God and gives an example of "a workman that needeth not to be ashamed."

5. **SON:** Thou, therefore, my \_\_\_\_\_, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus, and the \_\_\_\_\_ that thou hast \_\_\_\_\_ of me... the same commit to faithful men who will teach others also. (Learn from faithful men and teach others.)



6. **SOLDIER:** A soldier has to endure many hardships. Sometimes it is weather related, other times it is the lack of supplies, still other times it may be wounds suffered at the hands of the enemies. Such is the case of a Christian soldier. Paul told him he must endure \_\_\_\_\_ (hardships) as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. If you are fighting a war, you don't focus on business matters, relationships or even family. So spiritually, if you are fighting the war against the 3-headed enemy (world, flesh, devil) you do not get entangled in the affairs of this \_\_\_\_\_. (Ch 2: 3,4)



7. This life is too insignificant in comparison to eternity. Therefore when Paul comes to the end of this thought (v. 11) he gives this faithful saying, "If we be \_\_\_\_\_ (or die to ourselves) with him, we shall also live with him; if we \_\_\_\_\_, we shall also reign with him: If we \_\_\_\_\_ him, he will also \_\_\_\_\_ us; if we believe not, yet he abideth \_\_\_\_\_: he cannot deny himself." The visible church

may turn aside in unbelief, like Israel in the wilderness, yet God remains true to His word – He is faithful. Truth is His attribute...He cannot deny Himself.

8. **ATHLETE:** And if a man also strive for \_\_\_\_\_ (compete in athletics), yet is he not crowned, except he \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_ (abides by the rules).

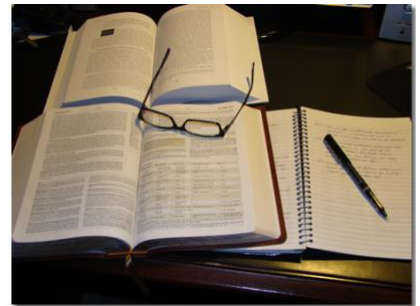


Athlete: strive lawfully for the reward

9. **FARMER:** The \_\_\_\_\_ that laboreth must be first partaker of the \_\_\_\_\_ (work before crops have fruit).



10. **STUDENT OF THE WORD:** They do not \_\_\_\_\_ about word to no profit. They \_\_\_\_\_ to show themselves approved unto \_\_\_\_\_ that do not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of \_\_\_\_\_ (properly interpret the Word of God). They shun \_\_\_\_\_ and vain babblings... but would rather increase more to \_\_\_\_\_. Hymeneus and \_\_\_\_\_ were caught in this profane and vain babblings... their word eats like a \_\_\_\_\_. They said that the \_\_\_\_\_ was past.



11. **A VESSEL:** They are vessels unto honor, sanctified, and meet for the \_\_\_\_\_ use, prepared unto every good \_\_\_\_\_ (clean and usable). They flee youthful \_\_\_\_\_. They follow \_\_\_\_\_, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a \_\_\_\_\_ heart. They avoid \_\_\_\_\_ and unlearned questions.



12. **A SERVANT:** They are gentle to all men, apt to \_\_\_\_\_,  
patient. In meekness they instruct those that \_\_\_\_\_  
themselves. (Living unconverted is an opposition to your eternal welfare.) The  
servant of the Lord seeks to show them that they are caught in the snare of the  
\_\_\_\_\_ and taken captive by him at his will.

13. "Snare" means: noose of cord or wire used to trap animals or birds., a trap.

14. They also preach the word, are instant in/out of season, reprove,  
\_\_\_\_\_ and exhort with all  
\_\_\_\_\_ and doctrine. (Ch. 4: 2)
